Launceston Primary School Build Update from Kier

Progress currently sits at a -6wk position due to effects of weather on the engineered fill solution. A Programming exercise is being undertaken to establish areas of recovery now that the steel erection commencement date has been finalised.

2.2 Progress in the Period

Main works

- Continue formation works to sports pitch.
- Completion of engineered fill works and testing to Jubb specification.
- Complete excavation of foundation bases and strip footings.
- Construction of reinforced cages to T5 foundations
- Poured 90% of foundations remaining due to be poured 24/01/24.

2.3 Proposed Progress

Items to be progressed in the next period will be:

Main works

- Complete formation works to sports pitch.
- Mobilisation of steel erectors and commence install of steel frame.
- Commence installation of drainage.
- Excavate and install attenuation tank.
- Install metal decking to first floor, reinforce and pour.

2.4 Matters Affecting Progress

Prior to the period

1. Sourcing a tip facility to accept the landfill material within the building has affect the progress of

the muck away activity associated with excavation works.

- 2. Availability of groundwork contractor following pause in project.
- 3. Weather conditions effecting the characteristics of the engineered fill 2 days lost in period.

During this Period

1. 2 days lost due to sub-zero conditions freezing welfare water supplies. Not seen to have effected

programme.
